



International Center for Photography Photography Labs/Teaching Facility New York, NY

This project converted an existing office building at 1114 Avenue of the Americas into a 27,000 sq ft, state-of-the-art classroom building for the world's largest photography museum-school the only one museum in New York solely dedicated to photography. Program areas include classrooms, black-and-white and color darkrooms, digital labs, photo studios, gallery, library, administrative offices, a professional shooting studio, student lounge, and student and community exhibition space. Additional resources for multimedia, digital photography, video editing and production are also accommodated. All laboratories are equipped with complete air conditioning, exhaust, and chemical and silver recovery systems.
